Year 3 Easter Play

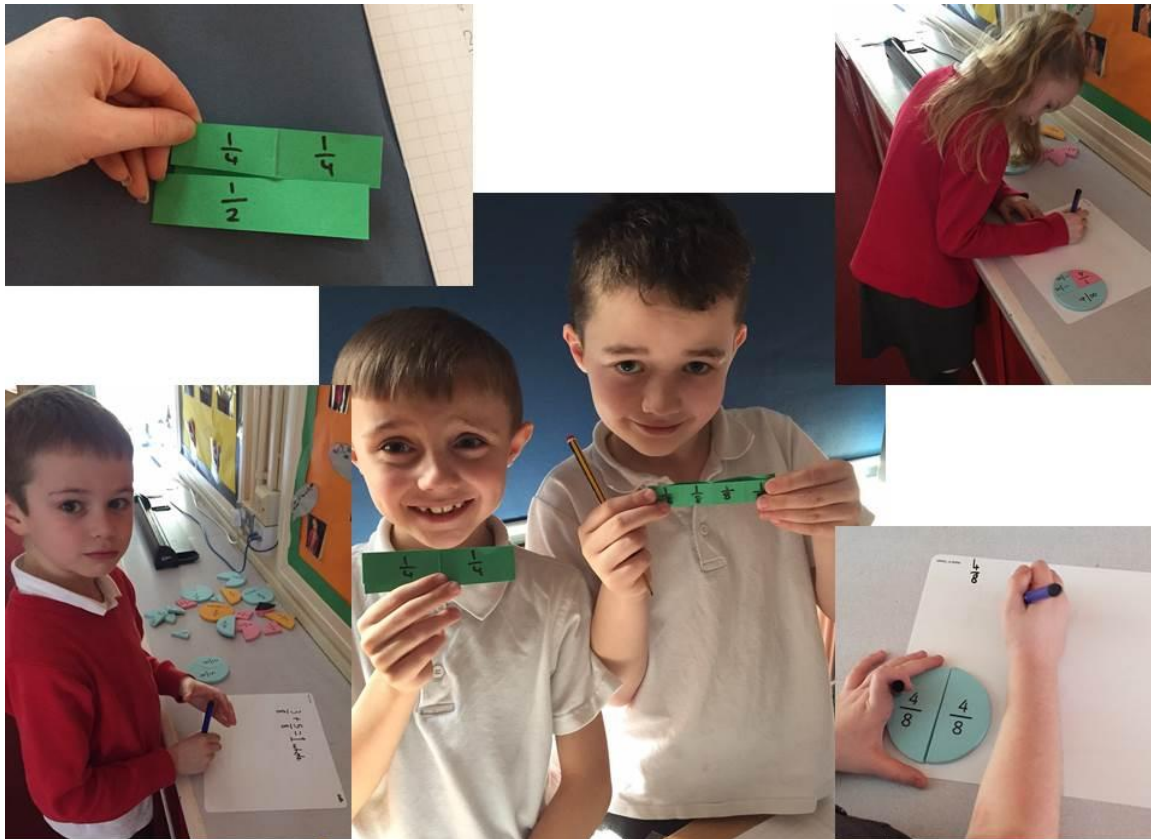
