### Punctuality Diaries

At our weekly Attendance Meeting we noticed that the punctuality for some of the classes was very poor. The children are missing the start of the day and the first input of their lessons; this will impact on their progress and attainment. We have introduced some punctuality diaries to those classes. One for home and one in school for the class teacher to monitor punctuality and celebrate those children who are in on time with rewards and treats. Please check with your child if they have a diary and use it to develop good habits of punctuality and attendance.
