Dismissal Arrangements

Dismissal of children is an important part of our role in safeguarding children. Organised dismissal ensures children's whereabouts is known, reduces the opportunities for anti social or exploitative situations and ensures safe return of children to their families.

While there are some clear guidelines and laws in relation to children there are also some less clear aspects to the guidance or law and hence school policy and systems are needed to give clarity and organisation.

Please take note of our policy and systems for dismissing children:

- Children from Nursery to Year 4 should be collected from school by an adult. This adult should be known to the child and the school. If there is a change to the usual practice for that child, the parent / carer should inform the class teacher at the start of the day in person or by note.
- For children in Year 5 and Year 6 parents/ carers should decide how they would like their child to be dismissed, where that is to an identified adult or to walk home on their own. If your child is in Year 5 or Year 6 and you wish them to walk home on their own, this should be documented on the slip below. If the slip is not returned, school will not give permission for a child to leave school without a parent / carer until the form is returned and the position on the child's dismissal clear.
- If a child is being collected by anyone other than the parent / carer and is to leave school with another adult, parents / carers should inform the class teacher. For example if a group of children are being collected by another parent for a party or sleepover, the class teacher must be aware. The person collecting your child should also be advised of which door your child will come through and which class they are in.
- If your child attends an after school club, the club must have written permission for the child to attend the club and a written agreement as to how the child is to be dismissed after the club. Dismissal after a club should adhere to the guidelines above.
- There is a form you may wish to use regarding dismissal changes at the bottom of the newsletter and also on the website under the 'Letters' tab.
