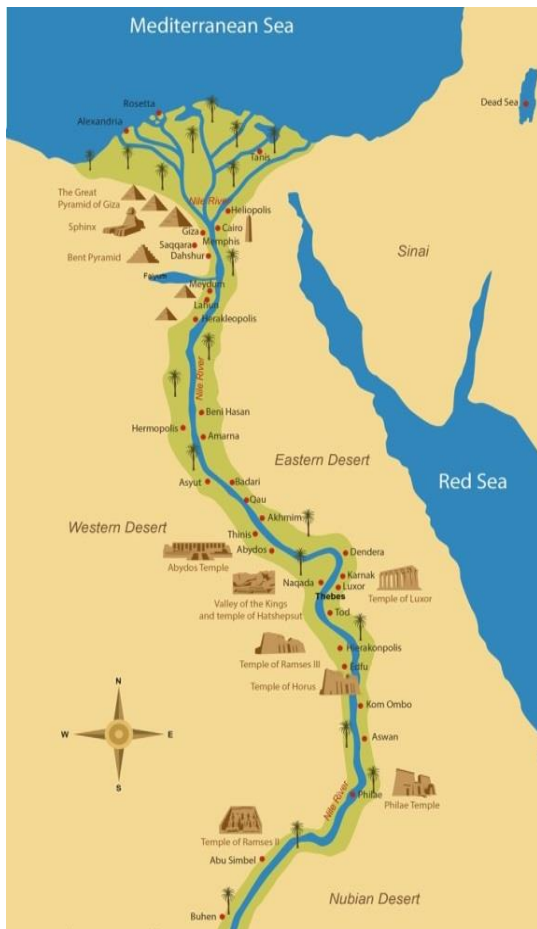


Knowledge Organiser Year 3– River Nile

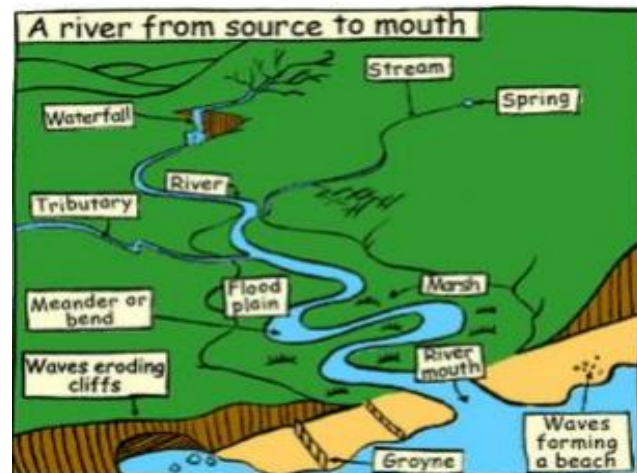
What should I already know?

- The **town** I live in is called Huyton.
- Huyton is in Liverpool, which is in the UK.
- There are **villages** and **towns** in Liverpool, some of which are **coastal**.
- The seven **continents** and five **oceans**.
- The **climates** of Australia and the UK are different.



Key Facts

- The United Kingdom is a country in the continent of Europe.
- The main river in Liverpool is the River Mersey.
- River Nile is in Egypt.
- Egypt is a country in the continent of Africa.
- Both the UK and Egypt are made up of **villages**, **towns** and **cities**.
- Egypt is much larger than the UK.
- Egypt and the UK have different **climates**. This means that the **weather** is generally different.
- Cairo is the **capital city** of Egypt.
- The longest **river** in the world runs through Egypt- the River Nile.
- The **climate** is hot and dry in Egypt and consists of desert **biomes**.
- Egyptian farmers divided their year into three seasons, based on the cycles of the Nile River
 - (June-September): The Flooding Season.
 - (October-February): The Growing Season
 - (March-May): The Harvesting Season

agriculture	Farming and the methods that are used to raise and look after crops and animals.
capital city	The city where the government sits. London is the capital city of England and the UK. Cairo is the capital of Egypt.
city	A large town. Liverpool is a city. Cairo is a city.
climate	The general weather conditions that are typical of it.
continent	A very large area of land that consists of many countries. Europe is a continent
country	An area of land that is controlled by its own government.
landmark	A building or feature which is easily recognised
oceans	One of the five very large areas of salt water on the Earth's surface.
river	One of the five very large areas of salt water on the Earth's surface
sea	A large, natural stream of fresh water that flows into the sea or a lake
season	Main periods of the year that can have their own weather conditions
town	A large group of houses, shops and buildings where people live and work. Towns are larger than villages but smaller than cities.
trade	The activity of buying, selling, or exchanging goods or services
Source	The start of the river, usually on high ground.
Stream	A narrow river.
tributaries	A stream or lots of streams that merge into a river.
estuary	The area where a river meets the sea.
mouth of a river	The end of a river, where the sea begins.
watershed	The edge of a river basin.
waterway	A route within a river that is used for travel.
river basin/drainage basin	The area of land from which water has drained into a river.
