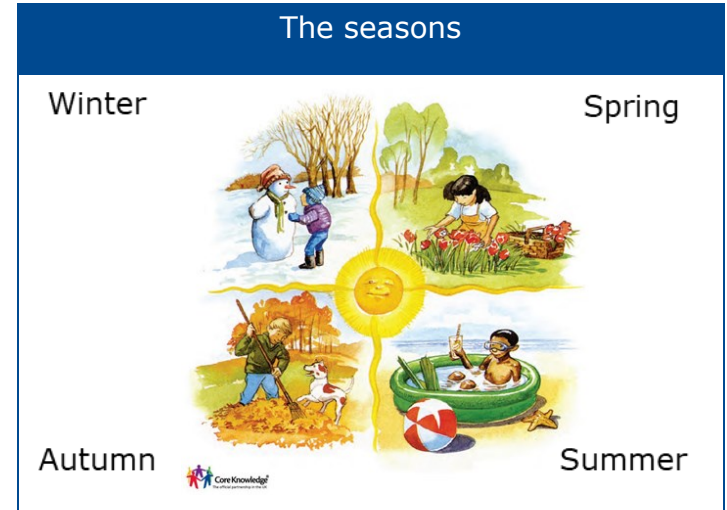










# Knowledge Organiser Science Year 1 Weather and Seasons

Key Vocabulary	
Season	The way the year is divided according to its weather
Weather	The daily state of the atmosphere, or air, in any given place
Temperature	A measure of how hot or cold it is
Data	A collection of facts, often numbers, that can give us information
Forecast	What the weather may be like in the next few days
Climate	The weather conditions in an area over a long period
Drought	Happen when it does not rain for a long time
Flood	A large amount of water covering the ground
Hurricane	A tropical storm with very strong winds and heavy rain
Rainbow	Form when the sun's rays strike raindrops falling from rain clouds
Wind	Wind is air moving around

	Weather vane	Used to measure the direction of the wind
