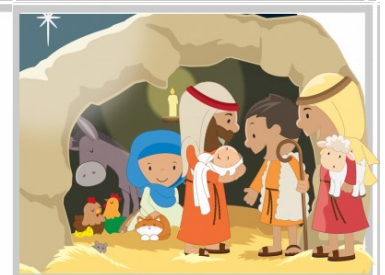
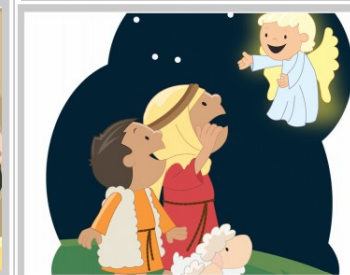
INCARNATION: Incarnation means that Jesus is God in the flesh, and that, in Jesus, God came to live amongst humans.

Key Vocabulary:

Gift: a present for somebody

Wise Men: clever people who visited and brought gifts for Jesus (Gold, Frankincense and Myrrh)

Magi: another word that means 'Wise Man'

Jesus: the Son of God whose birth we celebrate at Christmas time.

Promise: something that will definitely happen.

St Nicholas: a Christian Bishop who helped the poor and gave secret gifts to people who needed them.
