Antoni Gaudi  
**Born:** 1852 – 1926

A Spanish architect best known for his detailed structures throughout Barcelona.

In 1883, Gaudi was asked to take charge of the project of building a cathedral in Barcelona Sagrada Familia

Vocabulary	
<b>Architect</b>	A person who plans, designs, and oversees the construction of buildings.
<b>Mosaic</b>	A picture or pattern made by arranging together small pieces of stone, tile, glass etc.
<b>Composition</b>	Where the shapes or objects are put in place.
<b>Tesserae</b>	Small block of stone, tile or glass used to construct a mosaic.
