### Megan Coyle

An American artist and illustrator who resides in Brooklyn. She takes common, everyday magazines and turns them into works of art using the technique of collage.

### Fact

Megan refers to her artwork process as 'painting with paper'.

Vocabulary	
<b>Objective art</b>	Artwork that depicts easily recognizable subject matter. ... For example, a collage of a dog or zoo animal
<b>Non-objective art</b>	A form of abstract art.
<b>Abstract</b>	Artwork made from colour, shape, pattern rather than objects that you recognise.
<b>Mixed media technique</b>	When a variety of different textures and materials are used e.g. newspaper, photographs, wool, bubble wrap etc.

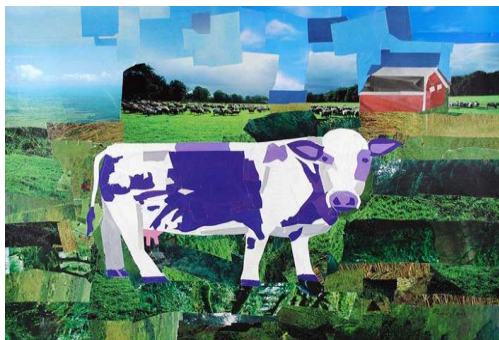
