Jean Michael Basquiat was first inspired by Picasso's painting - Guernica.

Vocabulary	
Grffiti	A term that refers to images or text painted on usually on to buildings. It may be spray painted, sketched, or scratched on to walls.
Street-art	Art that can be found on the street that encompasses a variety of mediums like painting, sculpture, or stained glass.
Neo-Expressionist	Portrays the human body and other recognisable objects in a basic and often personal perspective.
Mono-printing	A form of printmaking where the image can only be made once.
Brayer	A printer's hand inking roller.
