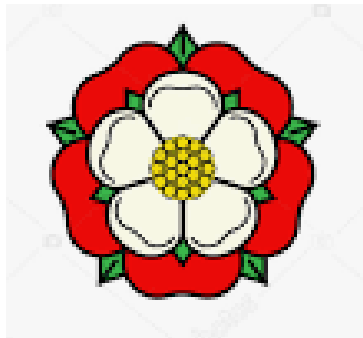

Phonics & pronunciation we will see:

Recommended phonics focus: **I IN IQUE ILLE**

- **IN** sound in **juin** & **intelligente**
- **I** sound in **Henri, civile, avril, cousine** & **ligne**
- **ILLE** sound in **vieille**
- **IQUE** sound in **catholique**
- **Silent letters.** You will hear and see that the 's' is not pronounced in **Palais, très, mais, roses** or **épouses**. The final 's' on words in French is often a silent consonant.
