### Summer Reading Challenge

Huyton library have visited school this week to launch, 'The Summer Reading Challenge'. The reading challenge is designed for children aged between the ages of 4 and 11. It is completely free to register and complete and last year 699,076 children took part in libraries across the UK. Every year the Challenge has a new theme, this year's theme is Space Chase, an out-of-this world adventure inspired by the anniversary of the first moon landing. Children can sign up at Huyton library, then read six library books of their choice to complete the Challenge. There are exclusive rewards to collect along the way, and it's FREE to take part!

### ESafety APP - Ourpact

There is an app called 'Ourpact' which can be downloaded by parents onto their phone and they can then use it to control apps such as Snapchat or Instagram. Parents can use the app to limit the use for example to an hour in the morning - goes off for school lessons, comes back on for some time in the evening and goes off at 10pm for the night. Please investigate and see if this can support you in keeping your child safe when using their phone.
