



Huyton with Roby CE Primary School – COVID Visitor Information

We are seeking the support of those who visit our school site, in helping us to minimise the risk of Coronavirus (COVID-19) to our community.

With this in mind, and in line with guidance from Public Health England, please refrain from entering the school site for any reason if you have a recent onset of a:

- New continuous cough and/or
- High temperature (over 37.8)

In this instance you should stay at home and follow the government advice.

While you are on site, you will need to follow general good hygiene practice to stop the spread of any viruses. This includes covering your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze, putting used tissues in the bin immediately and washing your hands with soap and water often.

There are bottles of hand sanitisers located throughout the site. We would ask that you sanitise your hands upon arrival using the supplied gel and just before you leave.

If you begin to develop symptoms of COVID-19 whilst at Huyton with Roby School, please inform the office who will contact a member of the leadership team who will advise you. If you develop such symptoms within 14 days of visiting Huyton with Roby School, please inform us on 0151 477 8460 / huytonwithroby@knowsley.gov.uk as soon as possible.

We realise that this heightened approach may inconvenience you. However, we are taking the current situation very seriously and you will appreciate that our priority is the safety and wellbeing of our pupils and staff.

If you are here to work with children, please note:

- Children must be kept in their POD groups, for Huyton with Roby this is a year group but preferably a class. Children from different PODs cannot be mixed.
- Children should be encouraged to keep some distance from others where possible.
- Adults must socially distance from children and from other adults.
- You must only use the area of the school you have been allocated and must clean/wipe down equipment between uses if children are sharing it. (Wipes are available around school or on request from the school office)
- If you move between pods you must wash/gel your hands on leaving and entering a pod.
- We are limiting the transfer of resources and equipment between home and school. Wipes or quarantine should be used to ensure items are kept as clean as possible.
