Key Vocabulary:

Miracle: an amazing event that is impossible to explain but shows God's power/Jesus was the Son of God.

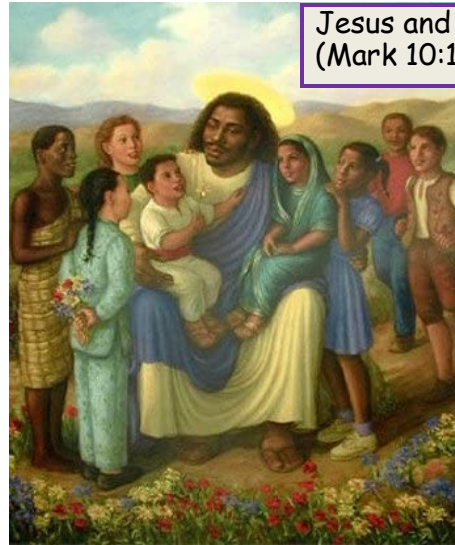
New Testament: The second part of the Bible.
