

Key Vocabulary:

Cross: A structure that Jesus was crucified on.

Crucifix: A cross with a figure of Christ on.

Paschal candle: A large church candle blessed and lit at Easter, then used at

special times during the year.

Resurrection: Come alive again like Jesus did.

Last Supper: The last meal that Jesus shared with his disciples.

Eucharist: The Holy Communion. (Bread and Wine)

Symbol: A thing that represents or stands for something else.

Light of the World: Jesus said 'I am the Light of the world' about himself.

Sacrifice: to take the place of something

Celebration: A special event when you celebrate something.
