Musician	A person who plays a musical instrument, especially as a profession, or is musically talented.
Band	A group of musicians who play modern music together.
Local	Relating to a particular area.
Manager	A person who controls the professional and business activities of a performer, sports player, group of musicians
Fans	A fan, or fanatic, or supporter, is a person who is enthusiastically devoted to a singer or band.
Album	A collection of recordings issued as a single item on CD, vinyl record, or another form.
Record	A thin plastic disc which plays recorded music, to be played on a record player.
Singles	A short record or CD featuring one main song or track.
Fashion	A popular or the latest style of clothing, hair, decoration or behaviour.

The Beatles key events

6th July 1957
Paul McCartney first meets John Lennon at Woolton Village Fete. Paul joins the Quarrymen a few days later.

16th August 1960
Pete Best becomes the bands official drummer

18th August 1960
The band plays under their new name 'The Beatles' in Hamburg

3rd December 1961
Brian Epstein becomes The Beatles Manager

13th January 1969
The Beatles last live performance.

February 1958
George Harrison joins the Quarrymen

January 1960
The band changes its name to the Silver Beatles.

21st March 1961
The Beatles play at the cavern for the first time.

9th November 1961
Brian Epstein goes to the Cavern and sees the Beatles for the first time

16th-18th August 1962
Pete Best leaves the band and Ringo Star joins.

10th April 1970
Paul publicly announces the break-up of The Beatles
