18<sup>th</sup> August 1960 The band plays under their new name 'The Beatles' in Hamburg

3<sup>rd</sup> December 1961 Brian Epstein becomes The **Beatles Manager**

## The Beatles key events

February 1958 George Harrison joins the Quarrymen

January 1960 The band changes its name to the Silver Beatles.

21st March 1961 The Beatles play at the cavern for the first time.

9<sup>th</sup> November 1961 Brian Epstein goes to the Cavern and sees the Beatles for 16<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> August 1962 Pete Best leaves the band and Ringo Star

10<sup>th</sup> April 1970 Paul publicly announces the

break-up of The Beatles
