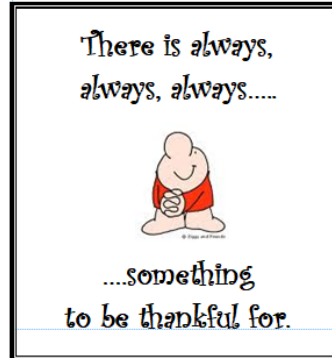




## **Huyton with Roby Newsletter – 1.7.22**

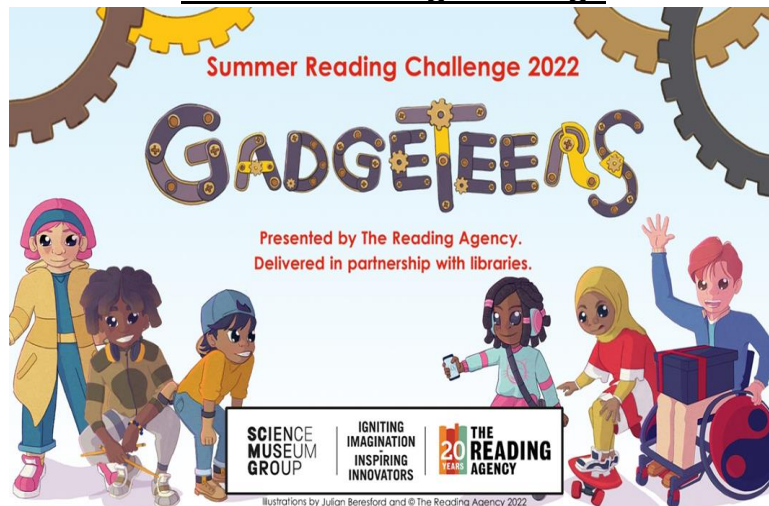
Our One Knowsley programme in 2022 plans to be even bigger.

## Summer Reading Challenge



The Summer Reading Challenge, presented by The Reading Agency and funded by Arts Council England, encourages children aged 4 to 11 to set themselves a reading challenge to help prevent the summer reading 'dip'. Each year the Summer Reading Challenge has a different theme. For 2022, The Reading Agency is partnering with Science Museum Group for Gadgets, a science and innovation themed Challenge that will spark children's curiosity about the world around them. This is a free, fun activity that can be completed during the summer holidays. Children can sign up at libraries across Knowsley; they can also create a profile at <https://summerreadingchallenge.org.uk/>. Here they can explore books to read, earn reading badges and play games linked to recommended novels.

We would love the children to bring in any completed reading activities or summer reading challenge certificates to share with new classes in September.
