Simple Greetings:

¡Buenos días! – Good Morning ¡Hola! – Hello ¿Cómo estás? – How are you? Estoy bien – I am well Estoy mal – I am not great ¡Adiós! – Goodbye ¿Cómo te llamas? – What is your name? Me llamo... - My name is...

Phonics and pronunciation:

- j pronounced like 'h' in hello
- ch pronounced like 'ch' in chocolate
- ñ pronounced like 'ny' in canyon
- Il pronounced like 'y' in yesterday
- rr pronounced like a rolling urr
- h in Spanish is always silent unless it is with a c
 (ch)
- Accents (ú) can only be added to vowels (a,i,o,e,u)
- Ñ tilde changes the 'n' to a 'ny' sound
