Grammar/Vocabulary:

sé- I know how

no sé – I don't know how

y – and

pero – but

No sé patina. – I do not know how to skate.

Sé bailar pero no sé cantar. – I know how to dance but I do not know how to sing.

Phonics and pronunciation:

- j pronounced like 'h' in hello
- ch pronounced like 'ch' in chocolate
- ñ pronounced like 'ny' in canyon
- ll pronounced like 'y' in yesterday
- rr pronounced like a rolling urr
- h in Spanish is always silent unless it is with a c (ch)
- Accents (´) can only be added to vowels (a,i,o,e,u) they indicate that the vowel is stressed
