Abstract artist.
He uses line, shape and colour.

“Drawing is taking a line for a walk.”

Vocabulary		
Abstract art	Artwork made from colour, shape, pattern rather than objects that you recognise.	
Line	A dot going for a walk. A line can vary in length, width, direction, curvature, or colour	
Pattern	Created by repeating a line, shape or colour over again.	
Printing	Making a copy of something by covering in paint and pressing it down on a material.	
Shape	An enclosed space created using lines.	
Colour	<u>Primary colours</u>	<u>Secondary colours</u>
	Red, yellow and blue	Orange, green and purple
