An English artist famous for painting scenes of life in the industrial districts of North West England in the mid-20th century.

HB (pencil)	HB refers to the lead grade in a pencil, H- hard B-black	 LS Lowry was an English artist Lowry was famous for painting urban landscapes with human figures. How to create texture using pencil techniques such as scumbing, hatching, stippling, feathering etc. Blend by smudging and other methods using oil pastels. Draw with an awareness of scale and proportion To create own work of art inspired by Lowry using paint To reflect on their artistic skills and identify any ways of improvement.
Pressure Blending	smearing/smudging two or multiple colours together	
Scumbling	a technique used to build areas of shadow and texture by drawing lots of little round loops, squiggles and figure of eight shapes.	
Scale	the size of a whole object in relation to another whole objects	
Proportions	The size of parts, that makes up the whole object.
