Vocabulary		
Ceramics	Ceramics are materials made from non-metallic minerals such as clay and sand.	
Pottery	Pottery is the process and the products of forming vessels and other objects with clay and other ceramic materials.	
Pinch pot	A pinch pot is a simple form of hand-made pottery produced from ancient times to the present. Simple clay vessels such as bowls and cups of various sizes can be formed and shaped by hand using a methodical pinching process in which the clay walls are thinned by pinching them with thumb and fore finger	
Coil	3d form made by arranging long strips wound in a joined sequence of concentric rings	
Imprint	a mark or outline made by pressing something on to a softer substance	
Slip	Liquefied clay particles in water.	
Score	Scratch hatch marks to join clay pieces together.	
Blending	Joining, gently pulling together two pieces clay.
